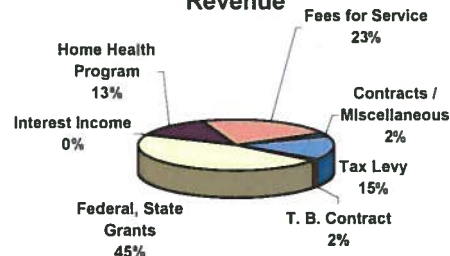

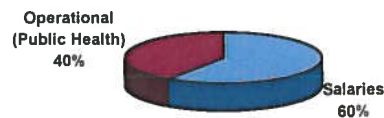
Revenues over Expenses (\$220,429)
